



Course overview

The number of adults who have either never used the internet or have not used it in the last three months has been declining over recent years. In 2018 there were still 5.3 million adults in the UK, or 10.0% of the adult UK population, who were classed as 'internet non-users', and although this figure has almost halved since 2011, there is still a vast digital skills gap in society.

This course will equip learners with an understanding and knowledge of the digital skills needed for life, work or further study in accordance with national standards. At Level 1, the focus is primarily on digital skills for work with a secondary focus on digital skills for life, but these are applicable across both life and work settings.

This course is available at level 1 or at entry level 3 – you can choose which level will best suit you and your learners.



Who is suitable?

This qualification is aimed at anyone who wishes to develop their digital skills in relation to life, work or further study. Anyone with a basic understanding of IT and digital skills wishing to improve their digital skills for their own personal use or for work purposes would benefit from the course.
